



2. The reference in the aforementioned Bill of Assurance to Lots 394, 395 and 396, shall henceforth be deemed to refer to said area as Lots number 394R and 395R, to correspond with the replat of said three lots into two lots.

3. Owners of Lots 391R, 393, 394R and 395R shall take title thereto subject to a reciprocal easement for ingress and egress across the area designated "easement" on the replat, in favor of the owners of the remaining four lots and Lots 19, 20 and 21, Block 23, Neimeyer Grove Addition to the City of Little Rock, Arkansas.

4. The "easement" shall be maintained by the owners of Lots 391R, 393, 394R and 395R, and Lots 19, 20 21, Block 23, Neimeyer Grove Addition to the City of Little Rock, Arkansas, at their equal expense.
