POOL ACCESS—ONLINE REGISTRATION SYSTEM

REGISTER BY MAY 21!

This provides easy entry to the pool. Once the online registration process is complete, you will only need to provide the gate guard your name/address and they will check you into the pool on a tablet. If you have changes to your registration or have not registered previously, please read inside for specific directions on how to register and if you haven't had your picture taken, do so on your first visit to the pool this summer.

Register by May 21st to ensure easy access opening weekend. Gate Guards can not approve registrations.

OWNERS MUST SUBMIT RENTER AUTHORIZATION FORMS EACH YEAR FOR RENTERS TO HAVE POOL ACCESS.

POOL RULES

Complete pool rules can be found on the St. Charles website under Pool News. These rules are also viewable during the online registration process and at the pool. Everyone will be required to acknowledge the rules at registration, so please familiarize yourself and your family.

POOL HOURS

The pool is open until **9 PM on Friday** evenings.

The pool opens to the public at **noon on Wednesdays. 10 AM—Noon Wednesday is Senior Swim** for residents age 50+

POOL GUESTS

- A daily fee of \$5.00 per guest is charged for each guest.
- **BEST VALUE! Buy 10 guest passes only \$35.** You can do this at the pool. Once purchased, these passes will be loaded into your profile, making it super easy to bring guests. We will be using Clover for guest pass transactions. **No cash will be accepted for guests at the pool.** Unused passes from last summer are still on file and valid.
- There is a daily limit of four (4) guests per **resident family** per day.
- Members must be 14 years or older to bring guests to the pool.
- Host residents must remain with their guests throughout their stay at the pool.
- These rules pertain to grandchildren guests—**4 per day family limit**, no guest fees for registered grandchildren.
- Registered babysitters (ages 14+) may attend and be responsible for resident children, no guest fee.

POOL PARTIES

Daytime pool parties and **after hours parties** will be offered at the pool this summer. Don't miss out having a party in our wonderful, newly renovated facility! See page 3 for details.

POOL OPENS: Saturday, May 27th 10AM

POOL RULES are located on the website and are part of the online registration process. Be sure to read the regulations and review them with your children. These rules apply to residents and guests.

POOL ACCESS REGISTRATION—COMPLETE BY MAY 21st for opening weekend use!

To get started with our online registration process, just go to:

sc.cellbadge.com/register

This link is also on the St. Charles website under pool news.

If you are already registered, there is nothing to do unless you have an addition or change.

For non-registered residents, follow the steps below.

Even if you don't want to swim, you will need to register to come hang out at the pool.

1. Go to sc.cellbadge.com/register
2. Request access on the green side for Initial Add Request. Once data is submitted, you will need to wait for management approval. You will get an email and text once approved.
3. You will then need to go back to sc.cellbadge.com/register.
4. This time enter information on the blue section. This is where you will enter/update your household members. Click request PIN - you will have a PIN texted and emailed to you. Enter the PIN and you will be logged into the registration page where you need to enter all your household residents. Please only enter live in residents. Once you complete registration you will need to wait for Management to approve. You will get a text and email when they do.

NOTE: The blue side is where existing registered residents can make updates if needed.
5. Be sure to select the appropriate category for each member as you register them. Choices include:
 - Owner
 - Renter (note: a completed approval form from the owner is required for processing. See form on www.stcharleslr.com/poolnews)
 - Child 10 and under
 - Child age 11, 12, 13
 - Child 14—15
 - Child 16 & over
 - Babysitter 14+ (non-resident/resident babysitters should be registered to bring registered St. Charles resident children—no fee)
 - Grandchild (non-resident grandchildren should be registered to be able to attend pool with resident grandparents—no fee)
6. You will be asked to agree to facility rules. Please review before checking the box. Then submit.
7. Once you receive notification of approval, the final step is for your **photo to be taken at the St. Charles Pool.**

Photos can be taken at pool opening for all who still need photos.

On the home page, sc.cellbadge.com, you will notice there is an announcements section where helpful information may be posted. ***This is also the best place to check if the pool is open or closed due to weather, etc.***

- 15 attendees includes residents/non-residents and swimmers/non-swimmers.
- Registered resident host family members are not included in the 15 count

Private Evening Pool Party

**2 hour party for up to 60 attendees total \$300.00
includes 2 lifeguards**

- Non-resident attendees depart when party is over.
- Member Community Association account must be paid in full and in good standing in order to book and host a party.
- All reservations are subject to Pool Manager approval. And should be made a minimum of 3 days in advance of party date.
- Reservations require completion of pool party request form and damages waiver along with payment in full .

ST. CHARLES POOL PRE-PAID GUEST PASSES

SAVE MONEY & TIME!

This year we are again offering pre-paid guest passes for purchase by residents in good standing. **For \$35 you can get 10 guest visits (good for adult or child guests).** No cash accepted.

This is a great way to save on guest fees if you bring guests to the pool frequently. Remember, all guests must be accompanied by residents with valid pool access.

Guest passes can be purchased at the front gate once the pool opens. Unused guest passes from last year are still valid and remain loaded into your profile.

? Pool FAQs

How old must you be to go the pool without adult supervision?

You must be **11 years of age and pass an Advanced Youth Swim Test** each year. Swimming proficiency tests will be administered to children 11, 12 and 13 who want to attend without an adult. Information on the test is available at the pool. You must be **14 years old** to bring guests to the pool.

Is there a guest fee?

Yes. Guests are registered at check-in and are **\$5 for a daily pass**. Guest fees are waived for registered grandchildren of residents when accompanied by a resident grandparent. There is a **four** guest per family per day limit. Residents must remain in attendance with guests at all times.

What happens the last 10 minutes of every hour?

Guards will signal time to exit the pool for all swimmers under 16. Non-walking infants only may remain in the pool with a parent/adult guardian during this time.

What happens at 1 hour before closing?

Guards will signal time to exit pool for all swimmers under 16 unless directly supervised by a parent/guardian.

Can I ride down the slide with my child or my friend?

For safety purposes, only one rider is allowed on the slide at a time.

This form and the **St. Charles ACC Guidelines** booklet can be found on the St. Charles website.

These requests can be mailed or emailed to the Association at stcharleslr@hotmail.com. Allow up to 30 days for review.
