ACC Guidelines & Forms Available Online

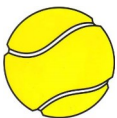


Please be sure to visit the St. Charles Community Association website at www.stcharleslr.com

Click on the Architectural Control heading to gain access to the ACC Guidelines Booklet and the Architectural Request Form. Complete the form and submit via email or mail to St. Charles Community Association.

Fences, home additions, decks and exterior modifications to your property require approval from the Architectural Control Committee **prior to beginning work.**

Please include project details, contact information and proposed timing of the project. These requests can be mailed or emailed to the Association. Allow up to 30 days for approval.

Reminder: Please Avoid Street Parking

Please help keep our neighborhood looking nice by **avoiding parking vehicles in the street**. In addition to detracting from the look of the community, it can also be an inconvenience and hazard for neighbors and emergency response vehicles. Use your driveway or garage for vehicle parking. Remember, it is against City ordinances to park vehicles on lawns.



This was the advice of the LRPD at a recent meeting. Please report any activities of concern to the LRPD. Both the non-emergency police number and 911 are options for citizens, depending on the circumstance.

Reporting any suspicious activities or concerns to the LRPD allows them to have the data necessary to determine staffing and patrols.

Also, be sure to:

- **Keep outside lights on at night.**
- **Lock all vehicles.**
- **Do not leave anything in your car. Even if it isn't valuable, a thief may not realize this and may still attempt a theft.**
