Pool Opens Saturday, May 23

POOL ACCESS & REGISTRATION

Register by Friday, May 15 at Noon for Opening Weekend Access

- If your family is already registered **and nothing has changed**, no action is needed.
- If you are **new** or need to update your household information, see **Page 2** for registration instructions.
- Once registered, simply give the gate guard your **name/address** for quick check-in.
- If you have not had your photo taken, it can be done on your first visit.
- **Gate guards cannot approve registrations.**

Renters: Property owners must submit a **Renter Authorization Form** each year for renters to receive pool access.

POOL RULES

- Complete pool rules are available on the St. Charles website under **Pool News**, during online registration and posted at **the pool, as well as in this newsletter.**
- All members must acknowledge the rules during registration.

POOL HOURS

- **Fridays:** Open until **9:00 PM**
- **Wednesdays:** Public swim begins at **Noon** : **Senior Swim (Ages 50+):** Wednesdays **10:00 AM – Noon**
- **NEW Sunday Hours: Noon – 7:00 PM**

POOL GUESTS

- Guest fee: **\$5 per guest / per day**
- **Best Value:** 10 Guest Passes for **\$35**
- Passes are loaded to your household profile for easy use
- **Unused passes from last summer remain valid**
- **Credit card only** for guest pass purchases
- **No cash accepted; 3.99% processing fee applies**
- **Limit 4 guests per resident family per day**
- Members must be **14 or older** to bring guests
- Host resident must remain with guests during visit
- Grandchildren count toward the 4-guest limit, but no guest fee if registered in our system
- Registered babysitters (age 14+) may supervise resident children at no charge

Get Ready for Summer!

POOL OPENING DAY **Saturday, May 23 | 10:00 AM**

IMPORTANT DEADLINE: Complete Pool Registration by
May 15 at noon to use the pool on opening weekend.

HOW TO REGISTER:

Visit: sc.cellbadge.com/register (Also available on the St. Charles website under Pool News and in the app store.)

Already Registered?

No action is needed **unless** you need to update household members or information.

First-Time Registration / New Residents

STEP 1: Request Access

- Go to sc.cellbadge.com/register
- Use the **green section** labeled **Initial Add Request**
- Submit your information
- Wait for management approval (You'll receive a text and email)

STEP 2: Add Household Members

Once approved, return to the site and use the **blue section**

- Click **Request PIN**
- A PIN will be texted and emailed to you
- Enter the PIN to log in
- Add all household members who live in your home; select the appropriate category for each resident (above)
- Submit for final approval
- **Registered residents: Use the blue section anytime you need to update information.**

FINAL STEP: PHOTO ID

Once approved, any member needing a photo may have one taken on your first pool visit of the season or you can upload one.

MEMBER CATEGORIES

Please choose the correct category for each person:

- Owner
 - Renter*
 - Child (10 & under)
 - Child (11–13)
 - Child (14–15)
 - Child (16+)
 - Babysitter (14+) – no fee, must be registered
 - Grandchild – no fee, must be registered
- * **Renters:** Owner approval form is required before access can be approved.

Pool Rules

Pool rules are part of registration and available on the website. Please review them with your children.

Even if You Don't Swim...

Residents must still register if they plan to visit or relax at the pool area

Fees Must Be Current

All resident fees must be paid and current to receive pool access approval.

2026 POOL PARTY INFORMATION

*The St. Charles pool is a great place to have a party!
Reserve your spot early, before they fill up.*

Semi-Private Daytime Pool Hours Party

2 hour party for up to 15 attendees \$150
includes use of two tables on the deck
or 1 picnic table

Options include: 11 AM – 1 PM
1:30 PM – 3:30 PM
Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday

- 15 attendees includes residents/non-residents and swimmers/non-swimmers.
- Registered resident host family members are not included in the 15 count
- Non-resident attendees depart when party is over.

Private Evening Pool Party \$300

**2 hour party for up to 60 8 PM—10 PM (Mon.—Sat.)
7 PM—9 PM (Sun.)**

- Member Community Association account must be paid in full and in good standing in order to book and host a party.
- All reservations are subject to Pool Manager approval. And should be made a minimum of 3 days in advance of party date.
- Reservations require completion of pool party request form and damages waiver along with payment in full .

? Pool FAQs

How old must you be to go the pool without adult supervision?

You must be **11 years of age and pass an Advanced Youth Swim Test** each year. Swimming proficiency tests will be administered to children 11, 12 and 13 who want to attend without an adult. Information on the test is available at the pool. You must be **14 years old** to bring guests to the pool.

Is there a guest fee?

Yes. Guests are registered at check-in and are **\$5 for a daily pass**. Guest fees are waived for registered grandchildren of residents when accompanied by a resident grandparent. There is a **four** guest per family per day limit. Residents must remain in attendance with guests at all times.

What happens the last 10 minutes of every hour?

Guards will signal time to exit the pool for all swimmers under 16. **Non-walking infants only** may remain in the pool with a parent/adult guardian during this time.

What happens at 1 hour before closing?

Guards will signal time to exit pool for all swimmers under 16 unless directly supervised by a parent/guardian.

Can I ride down the slide with my child or my friend?

For safety purposes, only one rider is allowed on the slide at a time.



ST. CHARLES POOL PRE-PAID GUEST PASSES

SAVE MONEY & TIME!

This year we are again offering pre-paid guest passes for purchase by residents in good standing. **For \$35 you can get 10 guest visits (good for adult or child guests).** No cash accepted.
3.99% processing fee

This is a great way to save on guest fees if you bring guests to the pool frequently. Remember, all guests must be accompanied by residents with valid pool access.

Guest passes can be purchased at the front gate once the pool opens. Unused guest passes from last year are still valid and remain loaded into your profile.

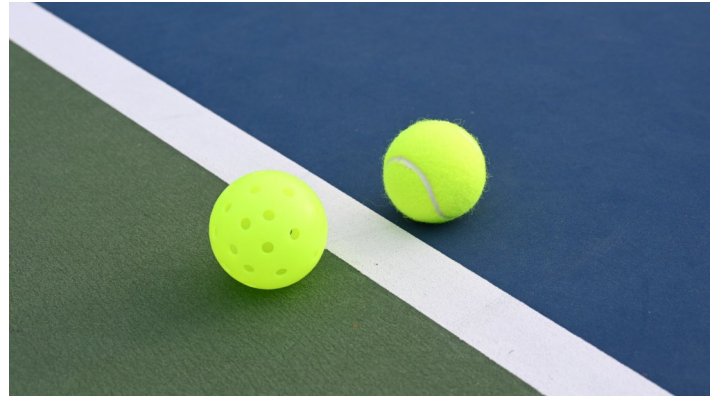

Updating Your Property?

Get Approval First!

Any building additions or alterations of any type to the exterior of the structure or grounds must be submitted to the St. Charles Community Association Architectural Control Committee (ACC) for approval using the **Architectural Change Request Form** prior to beginning work. This form and the **St. Charles ACC Guidelines** booklet can be found on the St. Charles website.

These requests can be mailed or emailed to the Association at stcharleslr@hotmail.com Allow up to 30 days for review.

All Assessments should be paid in full.

If you have not paid, please email the Association for your balance due. Pool and court privileges have been suspended for all accounts with balances due.

Remember: Delinquent property owners will be responsible for all costs associated with filing and removal of liens.
