ACC Guidelines & Forms Available Online



Access the Architectural Control section of www.stcharleslr.com for more information.

Click on the Architectural Control heading to gain access to the ACC Guidelines Booklet and the Architectural Request Form.

Complete the form and submit via email or mail to St. Charles Community Association. Be sure to provide documentation to ensure prompt processing. This includes project details, contact information and proposed timing of the project. Allow up to 30 days for review and approval.

All exterior modifications to your property including fences, decks and home additions to your property require approval from the Architectural Control Committee prior to beginning work.

Please take measures to minimize the opportunity for crime—leave lights on, lock cars and homes, don't leave anything in your vehicles.

If you are a victim to an incident, unless the break-in is actually occurring at the time you are reporting it, please don't call 911. The easiest ways to report are:

LRPD TRU. The LRPD has set up a Telephone
Reporting Unit (TRU). This service is available from
8 am to 8 pm Monday through Friday. If you have
an issue that does not require 911 assistance, such
as after-the-fact thefts, credit card fraud, loss of a
license plate, etc., you can call (501) 918-4397 or
email TRU@lttlerock.gov, provide your contact information, and indicate that you need to make a report.
A TRU representative will get back in contact with
you.

"Your LRPD" APP. The LRPD app is now available in the App Store. Please <u>do not use it for emergencies</u>, but it can be used for the same types of reports as the TRU. It also includes a Virtual Desk Sergeant, which can assist you with many different types of issues.

Being a Good Neighbor — For People and Pets

We love our four-legged friends, but living close together means being mindful of how our pets affect neighbors. Here are a few key reminders for dog owners:

Barking: Dogs will bark, but prolonged or late-night barking can disturb others. Please bring pets inside if barking continues.

Clean Up: Always pick up after your dog. Carry bags and dispose of waste properly to keep our neighborhood clean.

Leash Up: City rules require dogs to be leashed in public. This keeps both pets and people safe.

No Roaming: Dogs should never be left to run loose outside your property.

City of Little Rock Rules

The City requires leashes in public areas, owners to clean up pet waste, and prohibits nuisance barking and free-roaming dogs. Animal Services can be reached at **501-376-3067**.

If Issues Arise:

Kindly talk with your neighbor—many times they may not be aware of the situation.

If it continues, call **Animal Services** or **Code Enforcement** for support.

Let's all work together to keep our neighborhood safe, friendly, and enjoyable for people and pets alike!
